

# Finding Access PPO network providers


#### Access PPO offers you the freedom to choose any licensed provider for your care.

However, you'll pay less for care when you choose from among the more than 1 million providers nationwide who are in-network preferred providers. Here are the 3 provider directories you can use:

## 1. For Washington providers go to **kp.org/wa/directory**

In Washington state, you have more than 30,000 providers to choose from,\* including most major hospitals and medical groups. Whether you're looking for a personal physician, a specialist, an urgent care center, or an alternative care provider, you'll generally find what you need.

Filters in this directory allow you to expand or shrink the geographic range of your search results. You can also filter by gender, specialty, language, and more.


If you don't find the location or in-network providers you want at kp.org/wa/directory, you have access to 2 additional provider networks we contract with.

#### 2. First Choice Health Network

For Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, and Alaska, go to fchn.com

To find a provider:

- Fill in the **Find a Provider** fields for location, specialty, and name (if you have one), then hit **search**.
- A pop-up will ask you to select "Entire First Choice Health PPO Network," "Employer/Group ID," or "Employer/ Group/Trust Name." Select "Entire First Choice Health PPO Network." Then view your results.




#### 3. First Health Network

#### For all other states, go to myfirsthealth.com

Outside the Pacific Northwest, you have the First Health national network. This network is extensive with 5,000 hospitals and over 1 million health professionals.

- To find providers, click "Start Now," select the type of provider you're looking for, and decide whether you want to search by ZIP code or state.
  Fill out the appropriate fields related to location.
- Click on "Search now" to view your results.
